

## **Haiti HVM Mission Trip Know Before You Go**

### **Passport:**

- Current and valid for 90 days beyond your return date

### **Vaccinations:**

- Hepatitis A and B (begin series several months prior to travel)
- Tetanus
- Typhoid
- Anti-Malaria Medicine
- Recommend you consider using Doxycycline 100mg
- Visit [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov) and type in the name of the country you're visiting in the window

### **Mosquitos (protect yourself):**

- Malaria
- Chikungunya Virus
- Dengue Fever
- Zika Virus

### **Daily Challenges**

- Hydration
- Sun Protection
- Local Food and Water
- Facilities
- Hygiene

### **CLIMATE:**

- High 90' - Low 74', HUMID
- 11 Hours of daylight, expect rain in afternoon/evenings, wind is optional

### **Insurance:**

- Travel insurance is recommended
- Health insurance – check with your provider regarding international coverage

### **Important notes:**

- Do not tell any of the children that you would “love to take you home” or similar statement
- Pastor Andy will hold a briefing upon arrival

**Embrace opportunities to share the gospel or minister**
